- Founded in 1984 by Elliot Hoffman of Just Desserts and Bruce Lilienthal, Head of Business School at San Francisco City College
- Drove the defeat of Prop K (Gross Receipts Tax)
- Advocated for the creation of the Small Business Commission
- Sponsored "candidate nights" with mayoral candidates
- Instrumental in persuading Mayor Willie Brown, Jr. to fund and staff the Small Business Advisory Commission, now a Charter commission
- Engages with the Mayor and Board of Supervisors regarding:
 - Public policy
 - Fairness to small business
 - The cost of doing business in San Francisco
 - Effective management and fairness of City procurement policies
 - Mayoral and community support for locally owned businesses
 - Start-up of Small Business Assistance Center ballot measure – Prop. I
